

COVID 19 Protocols-updated

10/7/2021

Based on the recommendations of Saskatchewan Health Authority, below are WCC updated protocols:

Masking

- Staff and children aged 3 and up are mandated to mask when in the Centre
- Staff are not to eat with children who are unmasked
- Staff are asked to mask outside while in close contact with children.
- Masking for children outdoors is up to the parents
- Parents must mask when dropping off and picking up their children

Drop off and Pick Up

- Parents are to come into the centre (masked) to pick up and drop off their children
- Please check mailbox and parent board daily
- Sanitizer must be used upon entry into building

Sick Care

- There is no sick care provided at the Centre.
- Children that are displaying any symptoms of any illness are not permitted to be at the Centre and must stay home for 48 hours once symptoms have stopped.

Proof of Vaccine

- WCC Staff will have to show proof of vaccine no later than October 1, 2021
- WCC Staff who are not vaccinated must partake in the rapid testing program
- WCC Staff who are vaccinated are also encouraged to partake in the rapid testing program

Rapid Testing

- Rapid testing will be completed a minimum of once of a week to those who have signed consent
- Unvaccinated staff are to complete test twice a week
- Vaccinated staff will participate in rapid testing if they chose too

Self- Isolation/ Close Contacts

- Anyone who tests positive for COVID 19 must self- isolate for 10 days after receiving a positive test result
- Close contact of individuals who tested positive for COVID -19 will also be required to self isolate for 14days from the date of their last exposure if they are not fully vaccinated.
- Children who are considered close contacts are exempt from self isolation, to attend the centre, but must isolate when not attending the centre.
- All positive cases in your family, must be disclosed to WCC, children who are close contact from a household case, are not allowed to attend WCC

Centre Closures

- We will only close parts or complete Centre if directed by Saskatchewan Health Authority.
- In the case that the staff are not able to work due to sickness and or isolation, we will alert the parents as parts of Centre may need to close.
